VOTER INFORMATION FOR GENERAL ELECTION NOVEMBER 5, 2024

The Richardson County Clerk's Office is preparing for the November 5, 2024 General Election. Persons wanting to vote in the election are urged to check their voter registration status to make certain they are registered at the correct address to cast their ballot.

Voters may check their registration at <https://www.votercheck.necvr.ne.gov> or by contacting the Richardson County Clerk's Office at 402-245-2911.

Voter registration is taken at the Office of the Richardson County Clerk during regular business hours until Friday, October 25 at 6:00 p.m. Voters can also register at <http://ne.gov/go/NEreg2vote>. The deadline for any voter registration form other than in person is Friday, October 18.

Early voting will begin in the Office of the Richardson County Clerk on Monday, October 7 during regular business hours 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Early voting applications are also available to request that your ballot be mailed to you if you are unable to vote at your regular polling place on Election Day.

October 25 is the last day to request a ballot to be mailed to voters and an application form can be found in today's edition or on the Richardson County website www.richardsoncountyne.gov.

All-Mail voting precincts are: Arago/Barada, Salem, East Muddy and Grant/Nemaha. Voters who reside within these precincts will receive their **ballots in the mail on or after October 16, 2024**. Please notify the County Clerk's Office with questions regarding the All-Mail ballots.
