1. Verify that there are initials of an election official at the bottom of the ballot.
2. Verify that there are no voting marks on the ballot.
3. Use a black ink pen to mark the ballot.
4. TO VOTE, you must darken the oval (●) completely.
5. To vote for a WRITE-IN candidate, write in the name on the line provided AND darken the oval completely.

ABSENTEE/EARLY VOTING BALLOT INFORMATION

May 13, 2024, 5:00 p.m. is the deadline that a voter can vote early in the County Clerk's Office. (NE §32-942) The Office of the Richardson County Clerk is open from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for early voting. The office is located on the 2nd floor of the Courthouse, Room 203.

May 14, 2024, 7:00 p.m. is the deadline for a voter's agent to pick up an absentee/early voting ballot for a voter. (NE §32-943)

ABSENTEE/EARLY VOTING BALLOTS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE OFFICE OF THE RICHARDSON COUNTY CLERK BY 8:00 P.M. ON ELECTION DAY, TUESDAY, MAY 14, 2024, TO BE VALID AND COUNTED. (NE §32-950)

PROVISIONAL BALLOTS

Any registered voter who changes his/her residence within the county or due to marriage has changed their name since registering to vote, may be entitled to vote a provisional ballot (NE §32-915). Request this provisional ballot from the poll workers.

WRITE-IN VOTES

WRITE-INS ARE ALLOWED FOR THOSE OFFICES INCLUDED ON THE BALLOT, WHICH PROVIDE FOR A WRITE-IN. THE OVAL MUST BE BLACKENED FOR A WRITE-IN VOTE TO BE COUNTED. (NE §32-1005)

ACCEPTABLE FORM OF PHOTO ID IS REQUIRED TO CAST BALLOT

An acceptable form of photo ID is required to cast a ballot in Nebraska (Article I-22 Nebraska State Constitution). These acceptable forms of photo ID are one of the following: Nebraska driver's license (from NE DMV); Nebraska state ID card (from NE DMV); Nebraska college ID (public or private); Nebraska political subdivision ID (state, county, city, school, etc.); United States Passport; Military ID; Tribal ID; hospital, assisted-living facility or nursing home record (NE §32-123)

PROVISIONAL-VOTER IDENTIFICATION VERIFICATION BALLOT

If a voter does not have an acceptable form of photo ID, when arriving at their polling place, voters may request and complete the provisional-voter identification verification ballot procedure (NE §32-915.03). Voter will be required to present a photo ID at the Richardson County Clerk's Office on or before 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 21, 2024, in order for the ballot to be counted on Wednesday, May 22, 2024, by the Richardson County Canvassing Board.
