GENERAL PROVISIONS: This permit is granted with the understanding that:

Richardson County does not issue permits for overweight loads on county bridges, said permit routes will be denied. If no alternate route exists, applicant will be responsible for paying a (Richardson County approved) licensed Nebraska Engineer to verify load weights and axle spacings and submitting a written decision on permit approval to Richardson County. If said bridge or structure will not allow for the load, permit will be denied. Special circumstances may allow the applicant with engineer approval to make necessary improvements/repairs to bridge to allow permit approval. All improvement/repair costs and engineering fees to be paid by the applicant prior to permit approval.

All moves will be made during daylight hours. No moves will be made on Saturdays, Sundays, holidays or when roads become hazardous because of weather. Moves shall not be made when roads are rain saturated, covered with snow or ice or when visibility is unduly impaired by rain, snow, fog or any time travel conditions are considered to be unsafe.

Applicant is responsible for damages done to any and all roadways, road right-of-way, and road signage associated with the move. All damages must be restored to pre-move conditions.

If applicant does not restore road to pre-move conditions, or does so and settling or other problems arise, the Richardson County Road Department will contact the applicant and the applicant shall remedy any deficiency within 48 hours. If the applicant does not cure any such deficiency within the 48 hours the Richardson County Highway Superintendent to the reasonable satisfaction of the Richardson County Roads Department, then the Richardson County Roads Department shall preform the repair work reasonable and necessary to effect such cure and bill the applicant for expenses incurred. In the event any person, firm, or corporation fails to pay the damages herein the Richardson County may assess such damages upon the property in the same manner as other special taxes for improvements are levied and assessed, or Richardson County may sue any such person, firm, or corporation in any court of competent jurisdiction for the amount of the damages due and payable under the terms and provisions of this permit and may recover a judgment against said party for the amount so due together with interest and attorney's fees.

Richardson County requires that a minimum of 175 tons of rock, 1" clean or 1.5" crusher run be placed on each mile of rock roads. If damages require repair by Richardson County these shall be reimbursed at \$100.00 per hour for a motor grader and \$35.00 per hour for the operator; aggregate at cost; \$70.00 per hour for trucking and \$35.00 per hour for the driver.

The applicant assumes all liability and responsibility for any and all property damage or person injuries, which may occur by, through or in consequence of the movement of said vehicle, equipment or load. The applicant further specifically agrees that he/she shall be liable and responsible to Richardson County, Nebraska, for any damage to any county property, road signs, roadway, road structure, bridges, bridge approaches and public utilities which may occur by, through or in consequence of the movement of said vehicle, equipment or load. Applicant shall provide Richardson County proof of liability insurance in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) with Richardson County as a named insured.

The applicant shall comply with all laws of the State of Nebraska and all rules and regulations of the Richardson County Road Department, which have been or which may be herein after adopted relative to the use of the roads for movement of special vehicles or loads. This permit is issued only on county roads that this department has responsibility for.

This permit shall be carried in the vehicle to which it refers and shall be open to inspection by any law enforcement officer, authorized agent of the Richardson County Road Department, licensed engineer or licensed bridge inspector.

Violation of any of the terms or conditions of this permit shall automatically revoke it and the penalty of the original limitations shall be applied.

The Applicant shall be responsible for all trimming of trees and removal of the trimmings. Permission for trimming trees that are not on county right-of-way shall be obtained by the applicant prior to the move.

All signs along the route shall be lowered or removed as needed by the applicant and will be replaced immediately and in the same condition as prior to the move.

THE RICHARDSON COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT WILL BE NOTIFIED AT 402-245-2614, TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOURS PRIOR TO THE MOVE OR PRIOR TO MOVE IN AND PRIOR TO MOVE OUT. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL VOID THIS PERMIT.

The Richardson County Sheriff's Department will be notified, at 402-245-2479, of the date and time of the move or move in and move out.

Permit is issued only for the most direct route from the starting point to destination as shown on the attached map. A county representative shall accompany load when traveling over routes with bridges.

Permit fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) is tendered herewith.
