## RICHARDSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS DECEMBER 6, 2023

#### CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Richardson County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Caverzagie at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, December 6, 2023. Roll call was answered by Karas, Sickel and Caverzagie. The Invocation was given by Chairman Caverzagie and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Karas. Chairman Caverzagie announced that the open meeting laws have been posted at the entrance to the meeting room.

### 4 COUNTY JUVENILE DIVERSION SERVICES

Linda Volker, presented to the Board a report on the 4 County Juvenile Services program. and a summary of the services that are provided by Jill Hahn, mentor director.

Motion was made by Karas to approve and enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Johnson, Pawnee and Nemaha Counties to apply for Community-based Juvenile Services Aid Program Funds through the Nebraska Crime Commission for the year 2024-2025. ### ROAD DEPARTMENT

Steve Darveau, Jr., Highway Superintendent updated the Board on the routine road and bridge maintenance being done this past week.

He reported that construction has begun on the concrete box culvert construction site CO07423425 located on 704 Road 4 ½ miles west of Hwy 73 on Pony Creek Road. This project is expected to be completed by early Spring.

Road grading and rock placement on county roads was also reviewed.

Motion was made by Karas to authorize the advertisement to solicit for sealed bids for rock purchases in 2024 to be opened on Wednesday, December 27, 2023. Motion seconded by Sickel. ROLL CALL VOTE: Karas-aye, Sickel-aye, Caverzagie-aye. Motion carried.

#### LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER

Sheriff Hardesty updated the Board on the routine business within the Law Enforcement Center this past week. He reported that there were 666 calls with 447 of those traffic stops, 53 arrests of which 48 were by the Sheriff's department and from other agencies and there are a total of 20 inmates be held by Richardson County as of today. The "Stuff the Cruiser" event will be held in Falls City this Saturday to collect donations and toys for the Christmas season.

The Sheriff's Department will be conducting a "Drive Sobber" period this month from December 15 through January 1 with grant funding for this program being received from the NE Department of Transportation not to exceed \$10,000.

He also reported on seized monies totaling approximately \$27,000 from an illegal drug investigation and these funds to be submitted to the Federal Forfeiture program. Richardson County will receive a return of a portion of these funds.
